Cycling Challenge

FORMAT: Monthly Challenge

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS:

1. Single Participant
 - a. All distances cycled will count towards the Average Monthly Distance for your company.
 - b. Forming smaller teams within your company for accountability and more social interaction is strongly encouraged (If you'd like to find more people from your company or from the CCC community, join the Discord Server below).
2. No Gender Requirements

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Distance tracker (Strava, Bike Odometers, MapMyRide.Com or similar)
 - a. Join the Calgary Corporate Challenge Strava Club to share your results and see how other Strava users are doing.

GENERAL RULES

1. Participants can choose to cycle whenever is most convenient for them.
2. Participants will be allowed to submit multiple rides during the month. A cumulative distance travelled will be calculated every month/over the course of the 2020 Games.
3. CCC will endeavour to provide possible routes and pathways, but participants are welcome to cycle where they choose.
4. There will be no time limit for participants during their rides.

SCORING

- Participants will submit the date and distance travelled via the Cycling Challenge Form following every ride (*or, if they prefer, they can submit one form with a total km traveled for the month*).
- Any disputes must be reported to CCC Staff.



CCC PRINCIPLES OF FAIR PLAY

CCC reserves the right to disqualify, suspend, remove and/or otherwise sanction any manager, coach, player, spectator, team and/or company that conducts themselves in any manner contrary to the Principles of Fair Play before, during or after an event. Your team is effectively an extension of your company/workplace. As such, *all incidents will be reported to the Company Captain and Senior Management at your company.*

Principles of Fair Play

1. Respect the rules.
2. Respect the officials, CCC Staff and volunteers and their decisions.
3. Respect your opponents.
4. Respect your company and represent it well.
5. Maintain your self control at ALL times.

PROTESTS

All protests regarding rules, eligibility and unsportsmanlike conduct must be brought to the attention of the CCC immediately (info@calgarycorporatchallenge.com). CCC will address the situation immediately and decide on a course of action. The decision of CCC is final regardless of whether or not the rule in question appears in the event rules.

Formal complaints may also be lodged with Calgary Corporate Challenge (by phone or email) within 24 hours of the event/incident in question. CCC Staff members will endeavour to respond to complaints as quickly as possible, particularly in instances where the resolution will directly affect upcoming games.
